**Re: Authorization to Construct Pipeline Facilities, 2007 Construction**

Dear Mr. Bley:


I grant your request, filed on May 16, 2007 to proceed with construction of the Pennsylvania and West Virginia facilities identified in your Implementation Plan for commencing in 2007. These facilities include: (1) about 12 miles of the PL-1 EXT2 pipeline lateral (between station numbers 716+00 and 1352+00) in Centre and Clinton Counties Pennsylvania, including three horizontal directional drills; (2) construction of the new Perulack Compressor Station in Juniata County, Pennsylvania; and (3) the expansion at the existing Wolf Run Compressor Station in Lewis County, West Virginia.

This authorization also includes: (1) the approval of your project-specific Implementation Plan filed on February 13 and supplemented on May 17, 2007; and (2) the use of Access Road S2-AR-8, which was rerouted at the request of the Bald Eagle State Forest staff. Your request is in compliance with environmental condition numbers 1 through 10, 12, 14, 16 through 18, 21, 22, 25, 30, 31 through 33, 36, and 37 of the Commission's June 16, 2006 Order (Order) in the above-referenced docket.

In accordance with environmental condition number 36, we have determined that the project in Pennsylvania is consistent with the General Conformity Provisions of the Clean Air Act. Therefore, the project would not exceed the conformity threshold levels (*de minimus*) of the pollutants for which an air basin is in non-attainment.

I remind you that Dominion Transmission, Inc. must comply with any remaining terms and conditions of the Order, and that no other facilities in Maryland or in Pennsylvania, other than those authorized herein, has been approved or can commence without written authorization.
