

Thomas F. Farrell II
Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer

Thomas F. Farrell II has been chairman, president and chief executive officer of Dominion since April 2007.

Farrell joined Dominion in 1995 and has served as an officer of Dominion and many of its subsidiaries. He was executive vice president of Dominion from 1999 to 2003 and was president and chief operating officer of Dominion from January 2004 to December 2005. In January 2006, Farrell was named president and chief executive officer of Dominion and was elected Chairman of Dominion's board in April 2007.

He is a member of the board of directors of Altria, Inc. Farrell also serves as vice chairman of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations and is chairman of Edison Electric Institute. He serves on the board of visitors at Virginia Commonwealth University as well as the University of Virginia's College at Wise and is a member of the board of trustees of both the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts and Virginia Foundation for Independent Colleges. Farrell is currently chairman of the Governor's Commission on Higher Education, the Richmond Performing Arts Center, and the Virginia Business Council, and vice chairman and chairman-elect of the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation. He is a former member of the University of Virginia board of visitors, where he served as Rector. He has also served as a member of the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia.

He earned his undergraduate degree in economics in 1976 and his law degree in 1979, both from the University of Virginia.
