

On April 21, Dominion reached an historic agreement to make this space significantly cleaner.

Since 2000, Dominion has been working closely with the EPA, the state of Connecticut, and other government agencies on an historic agreement. The result is one of the most comprehensive efforts ever by an energy company to improve air quality.

Dominion agreed to make \$1.2 billion in environmental improvements, including new state-of-the-art pollution controls at its largest coal-fired power stations in Virginia and West Virginia. Sulfur and nitrogen emissions will be reduced by two-thirds. In addition, Dominion has committed \$14 million to environmental projects such as energy and land conservation.
